### MID-EAST: LOCAL AUTHORITIES TALK PEACE IN CORDOBA

(AGI) - Perugia, Nov 21 - The Second European Conference of Local Authorities for Peace in the Middle East, which runs from Nov 22 to 24, opens tomorrow in Cordoba, Spain. Said Flavio Lotti, head of the national union of local authorities: "The Cordoba meeting is an opportunity for local governments wishing to oppose European inactivity and sign new agreements which can boost our commitment to peace in the Middle East." The meeting will be attended by representatives of hundreds of local authorities from Israel, Palestine, Italy, France, Spain and the Netherlands. Its main objective is to strengthen cooperation between European and Middle-Eastern local authorities by decentralising peace promotion projects. The meeting was arranged by the Spanish Ministry of Cooperation and Foreign Affairs, Andalusia's Municipalities Fund for International Solidarity, Fons Catala' de Cooperaci3 al Desenvolupament and the Spanish Confederation of Cooperation and Solidarity Funds plus a number of Israeli and Palestinian counterparts.
